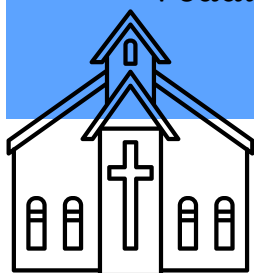
Enjoy the sun this weekend, let's hope this is the start of good weather to come.

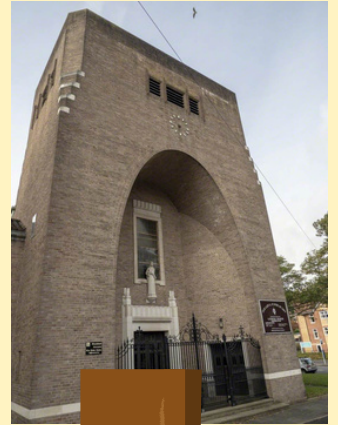

Autism and ADHD Advocates

Our Saturday morning SEN family support group is a relaxed and welcoming online space for parents and carers of neurodivergent children.

This is not a formal workshop. It is a friendly group meet-up held every other Saturday where you can ask questions, share experiences, and get practical advice from someone who understands. Many parents tell us they feel overwhelmed, unsure where to start, or exhausted from trying to figure things out on their own. This space is here to change that.

You can join with a specific question, or simply come along and listen. There is no pressure to speak. Some families attend regularly, while others join when they need support.

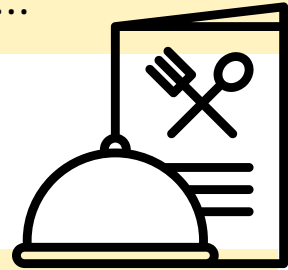

Please look over the menus and familiarise yourselves with the new options and choices.

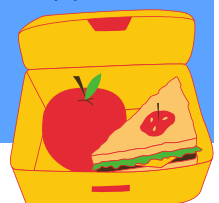


Healthy Lunchbox
